Prior to coming, the Mystery Reader (this could be a parent, grandparent, etc.) needs to fill out the form below giving us some clues about themselves to reveal to the children throughout the week. The children will try to guess who the Mystery Reader will be by the clues they are given. The mystery will be revealed when you arrive in our room. Please do NOT tell your child when you are coming! 5 and 6 year olds have a very hard time keeping a secret!

Because these stories often become favorites of the children, we ask that you donate the book to our room if possible (inexpensive books can be found in the Scholastic Book Clubs that go home every few weeks). You'll have about 15-20 minutes to spend reading and talking to the children (by the end of the day, 5 and 6 year olds can't sit much longer than this)!
